He was killed September 14, 2003 in Fallujah, Iraq. He had also served in Korea and Afghanistan prior to deploying to Iraq with the 82nd Airborne Division.

Trevor had asked his parents to do two things should he not return from his mission in Iraq. The first was to take care of his dog, Scrappy. As you can see Scrappy is doing fine.



The second was to take care of his guys, which has proven more difficult. After many prayers and meditation, the concept for Blum's Landing was born.
